The Department of Mathematics was established in 1958 and subsequently upgraded to the P.G. Department of Mathematics and Statistics in 1988. However, in 2004, the Department of Statistics was constituted as an independent Department. The Department of Mathematics further expanded its academic outreach by introducing Master's programmes in Mathematics at the South Campus in 2002 and at Government Degree College, Baramulla in 2005. The Department comprises a team of highly qualified and dedicated faculty members engaged in teaching and research in diverse areas, including Graph Theory, Mathematical Biology,

Complex Analysis, Differential Geometry, Functional Analysis, and Cryptography.
